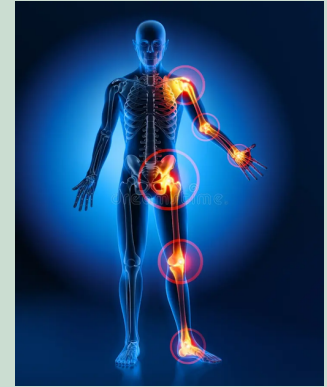


ARTHROGRAMS

WHAT TO EXPECT WITH YOUR UPCOMING PROCEDURE



What is an Arthrogram?	● An Arthrogram is an injection of contrast medium into a joint performed under image guidance ● After your injection, we will perform a CT or MRI scan to visualize your joint
Before Your Procedure	● You will need to be screened for MRI/CT safety ● If you are having a hip arthrogram, and are on blood thinners, we need to be aware.
Day of Procedure	● You will need a driver to and from the procedure ● There are no eating/drinking restrictions ● Your joint will be numb for 6 hours post procedure
Following the Procedure	● No heavy lifting for 24 hours ● Please hydrate as much as possible
